



## **Bunbury Village Day** **Competition Rules**

### **Cake Competition**

1. Cakes must be delivered to the judging tent before noon on Saturday 19th June 2010.
2. All exhibitors and the public must leave the judging tent by noon.
3. Each entrant must ensure that they are given a number for each of their entries.
4. Entry fees can be paid in advance or at the time of delivery.
5. Judging will be carried out in private and the public will only be allowed in to the judging tent after judging.
6. The judge's decision is final.
7. No attempt must be made to influence the judge or officials.
8. No attempt must be made to discredit or sabotage other entries.
9. The cakes in classes 1 – 6 and in class 10 will be tasted by the judge.
10. All cakes and awards must remain on display until 4.30pm.
11. Any cakes not collected by their owners after the venue is cleared will be disposed of.
12. Cakes must be the sole work of the entrant.
13. Whilst every care will be taken, The Bunbury Village Day Committee can not be held responsible for any article or person lost or damaged.
14. Cakes described as decorated are judged on decoration only and will therefore be disqualified if entered as a cookery item.
15. Each cake may only be entered in one class.
16. Exhibits and exhibitors may be photographed & the photographs used for Village Day advertising in the future. (on the web site or in print).

### **Battle of the Blooms**

1. Displays must be delivered to the judging tent before noon on Saturday 19th June 2010.
2. All exhibitors and the public must leave the judging tent by noon.
3. Each entrant must ensure that they are given a number for each of their entries.
4. Entry fees can be paid in advance or at the time of delivery.
5. Judging will be carried out in private and the public will only be allowed in to the judging tent after judging.
6. The judge's decision is final.
7. No attempt must be made to influence the judge or officials.
8. No attempt must be made to discredit or sabotage other entries.
9. All arrangements and awards must remain on display until 4.30pm.
10. Any arrangements not collected by their owners after the venue is cleared will be disposed of.
11. Arrangements must be the sole work of the entrant.
12. Whilst every care will be taken, The Bunbury Village Day Committee can not be held responsible for any article or person lost or damaged.
13. Each arrangement may only be entered in one class.
14. The use of artificial plant material is not allowed.
15. Exhibits and exhibitors may be photographed & the photographs used for Village Day advertising in the future. (on the web site or in print).

### **Scarecrow Competition**

1. All scarecrow entries must be on display in a clearly visible position at the front of the property on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> June from 2pm.
2. All entry fees must be paid by 5<sup>th</sup> June 2010.
3. The judge's decision is final.
4. No attempt must be made to influence the judge or officials.
5. No attempt must be made to discredit or sabotage other entries.
6. Any scarecrows not collected by their owners after the venue is cleared will be disposed of.
7. Whilst every care will be taken, The Bunbury Village Day Committee can not be held responsible for any article or person lost or damaged.
8. Exhibits and exhibitors may be photographed & the photographs used for Village Day advertising in the future. (on the web site or in print).
9. Scarecrows may be the work of an individual or a group of people.

It would be lovely if your scarecrow could continue to be on display in the week running up to & on Village Day. Please deliver your scarecrow to the display area on The Jubilee Playing Fields & collect after 4.30pm.

### **Tug-of-war**

1. The judge's decision is final.
2. No attempt must be made to influence the judge or officials.
3. No attempt must be made to discredit or sabotage other teams or equipment.
4. The public must not interfere with the tug-of-war
5. Whilst every care will be taken, The Bunbury Village Day Committee can not be held responsible for any article or person lost or damaged.
6. Participants may be photographed & the photographs used for Village Day advertising in the future. (on the web site or in print).

### **Colouring Competition**

1. The picture must represent a children's TV character past or present.
2. The judge's decision is final.
3. No attempt must be made to influence the judge or officials.
4. No attempt must be made to discredit or sabotage other entries .
5. The public must not interfere with any entrants work.
6. Whilst every care will be taken, The Bunbury Village Day Committee can not be held responsible for any article lost or damaged.

8. The colouring must be the sole work of the entrant.
